Hands-on learning and observation

As well as servicing the courses with restorations, the custom built lab also doubles up as a perfect location to provide hands-on training for all members of the dental team. Many of the Devonshire House education master classes take place at the lab where there is a fully equipped surgery and plenty of space for practical learning.

The surgery enables dentists to observe live implant surgery, and nurses and hygienists to receive implant related training, whilst the lab itself is often used for practising implant placement on models.

Taking the lab to the dentist
