An update on our protocols

Dear Clinicians,

Following the latest guidance, we are pleased to let you know that we are now able to remove some of the additional procedures and protocols that we introduced in response to Covid-19.

From 1st July we will no longer be asking patients to wear a mask whilst in the practice, nor taking their temperature on arrival, and we will also be reducing our use of disposable plastic PPE. These changes allow us to no longer be charging an additional fee for an AGP, as our team will be reducing the amount of plastic disposable PPE they use and wear.

We will carry on implementing hand hygiene measures and air filtration throughout the surgeries as they prove to be the most effective elements of our safety protocols. Furthermore, we will continue to monitor local COVID-19 infection rates and will reinstate the wearing of masks at Devonshire House if infection rates rise.
