

### When to refer patients for periodontal treatment

#### Dear Clinicians,

With 10% of the population appearing to suffer from the more severe forms of periodontal disease, referring these patients for specialist periodontal treatment can help prevent further dental problems such as tooth loss and loss of supporting bone. Furthermore, periodontal treatment may also be required to compliment some restorative procedures.

It can often be a borderline decision knowing whether to refer to a hygienist or to a specialist periodontist so we have put together a guide of key signs to look out for to assist you.


# When to refer your patient for Specialist Periodontal treatment - Key indicators:

- Stage IV or Grade 3 periodontal disease (more than 2/3 bone loss of the root length; 6mm + pocketing)
- BPEs of 3 and 4s
- Complex medical conditions related to periodontal involvement
- Non responsive patients following a course of initial periodontal therapy
- Vertical bone defects
- Periimplant mucositis (persistent bleeding on probing around implant)
- Periimplantitis (progressive bone loss, bleeding/suppuration on probing and pocketing greater than 5mm)
- Cosmetic soft tissue grafting for the correction of soft tissue defects
- Functional soft tissue grafting for creation of attached soft tissue

# Periodontal treatment may also be required to compliment the following restorative procedures:

- Crown lengthening- both aesthetic and functional
- Soft tissue grafting around pontics/crown margins
- Implant placement +/- hard and soft tissue augmentation
